Pursuant to Title 23 and Title 49, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requests your processing and approval of the attached amendment to the FY 2020/21 – 2024/25 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This amendment is required because a new project has been added to the work program and needs to be reflected in the TIP. The purpose of this project is to improve intersection lighting to enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety. This project involves converting the existing lighting fixtures to LED lighting and adding new additional LED lighting fixtures as required for each Intersection Lighting Retrofit project. This project is consistent with the goals of the Martin Metropolitan Planning Organization’s Long Range Transportation Plan, as well as part of the FDOT’s vision of achieving a fatality free transportation system.
