**South Florida Commuter Services (SFCS) Registration &
Instructions on how to connect the apps with your SFCS account.**

Step 1 – Registration:

1. Register with SFCS here (<https://commute.1800234ride.com/#/>)
2. Click on Register.
3. Add your Name, Last Name, Email and Password then click next.
4. Add your Home and Work zip codes and select the Bike to Work! network.

Selecting the Bike to Work network is very important so that the participant can be automatically included in the challenge.

Step 2 – Connect to your favorite App:

Commute Tracker

1. Install the Commute Tracker app from Google Play (Android) or the iOS App Store.
2. When prompted, grant the app permission to use your location. This permission is essential for automated location-based commute detection.
3. Log in to your SFCS profile and retrieve your PIN from the dashboard or the Connected Apps section of your user profile.
4. Enter the 6-character Connect PIN in the space provided.
5. Follow the prompts to provide information that allows Commute Tracker to detect and predict trips between your home and work. Make sure these are entered accurately.

Strava

1. Log into your SFCS profile.
2. Click your name in the upper right corner of the screen > Edit Profile > Connected Apps.
3. Click on Connect with STRAVA

Once you Connect your SFCS account with Strava, you will be prompt to the Strava login. Add your Strava's account credentials and log in.

4. Authorize SFCS to connect with Strava.
