6. AGENDA ITEMS

A. FY23-FY27 ROLL FORWARD TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AMENDMENT

Beth Beltran gave a brief overview on the FY23-FY27 Roll Forward Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment. She stated that each year, FDOT asks that those funds approved in the previous year that remain be "rolled forward" in order to be expended in the upcoming year.

A motion to approve the FY23-FY27 Roll Forward Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment was made by Samantha Lovelady and seconded by Robert Daniels. The motion passed unanimously.

B. TRANSIT EFFICIENCY STUDY SCOPE OF SERVICES

Beth Beltran introduced Jeff Weidner with Marlin Engineering and Jessica Josselyn with Kittelson & Associates who discussed the transit efficiency study scope of services. Jeff and Jessica gave a brief overview of the study and were available to answer questions.

Kim DeLaney asked if the study considers micro transit and rideshare and what kind of recommendations you usually use. Jessica Joselyn stated that right now they are more focusing on the shuttle and community transit.

E. TIP MODIFICATIONS AND AMENDMENTS

Beth Beltran gave a brief overview of the item and explained the modifications and administrative amendments that will allow FDOT to begin work on projects earlier than October 1, 2022. The FY23 TIP was modified to add additional funds to two I-95 resurfacing projects; an amendment to the FY22 TIP included the modified I-95 resurfacing projects as well as the Avalon Drive Sidewalk project.

7. COMMENTS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Kim DeLaney mentioned that the timeframe has changed between Tri-Rail and Brightline. Tri-Rail services will be split beginning in the summer of next year. Train 1 will be going to Miami International, and Train 2 will go into downtown Miami. Brightline construction will be done by the first quarter of next year.
