## US 1 at SW Palm City Road Feasibility Study Public Workshop

The Martin MPO will be hosting a public workshop for the US 1 at Palm City Road Feasibility Study in the Stuart City Hall on March 8, 2023 from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM.

The feasibility study will identify and evaluate alternatives and gather input from the public and stakeholders to select a recommended alternative to eliminate the free flow right and deter traffic from using SW Palm City Road as a cut-through to Monterey Road. 

#### 2045 Regional Long Range Transportation Plan

The Martin MPO, Indian River County MPO, and the St. Lucie Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) are currently underway with the development of the 2045 Treasure Coast Regional Long Range Transportation Plan (RLRTP). The RLRTP creates a regional overlay and gathers the transportation-related projects identified in the individual 2045 LRTP's from Martin, St. Lucie, and Indian River counties to create one long-term transportation plan for the future. The 2045 RLRTP will ensure connectivity and continuity between facilities throughout the counties, well integrated with land use, to meet community/county level and regional level transportation needs. 
## Stuart Adopts MPO Vision Zero Plan


